He continues, "The quick anilox-changeover system allows users to have up to three anilox rolls per unit - one in the working position and two in reserve. To complete the high tech configuration, Envases chose six Celmacch drying units - IR and hot air - for production on coated board. The whole machine boasts the latest generation of Siemens electronics to achieve the highest printing accuracy and reliability in the long term. We are proud of the trust that increasing numbers of leading companies have been showing towards our innovative products."
